

Health and Nursing Facilities Restrictions and Precautions for Flu and COVID-19 as of 3/13/2020

Canandaigua VA Medical Center - Do not visit if you any symptoms of respiratory illness, including cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath. You will be stopped at the entrance and will be asked questions pertaining to the above before you are permitted entry.

Clark Manor – As of 3/12/2020: **Closed to the public/no visitors**, including EMOHCs, until further notice. There is no current health concern, but they want to avoid having one. Will call when restrictions are lifted.

Clark Meadows/Ferris Hills – Do not visit if you have done any international traveling recently or if you have any symptoms of respiratory illness, including cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath.

Elm Manor – As of 3/13/2020: **Closed to the public/no visitors**, including EMOHCs, until further notice. There is no current health concern, but they want to avoid having one. Will call when restrictions are lifted.

Horizons – Currently has limited approval for activities and visitation, implemented 3/11/2020. Visitation will only be permitted between 1pm - 3pm and 6pm - 8pm. Doors will be locked 24 hours, and you will need to use the buzzer. At the entrance, you will be asked questions pertaining to symptoms of respiratory illness and international travel. Those that have any symptoms, including cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath, or those that have done any international traveling will not be permitted entry.

Ontario County Jail – Beginning 3/12/2020, visitors and providers will be required to complete a questionnaire and will not be permitted entry if they have recently been out of state, out of the country, or if they have any symptoms of respiratory illness, including cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath.

Ontario County Nursing Home – As of 3/10/2020: **Closed to the public/no visitors**, including EMOHCs, until further notice. There is no current health concern, but they want to avoid having one. Will call when restrictions are lifted.

Quail Summit – As of 3/12/2020: **Closed to the public/no visitors**, including EMOHCs, until further notice. There is no current health concern, but they want to avoid having one. Will call when restrictions are lifted.

Thompson Hospital/Ewing CCC – Per letter dated 3/13/2020: Visitor entry points are now limited and certain corridors are now restricted to Thompson staff only. Signage has been posted. Visits to the Ewing CCC are limited to those visiting residents who are receiving end-of-life care. If you are symptomatic (i.e., fever > 100.4 with respiratory symptoms) you are advised to stay home and call your provider's office.

Wilcox Lane – Currently has no restrictions for visitors. However, we ask that if you have had any symptoms of respiratory illness, including cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath, you refrain from visiting and/or bringing Communion.

Important! Additional information: *It is highly recommended that you wash your hands before and after entering a facility (and if possible, after entering individual rooms). If you are bringing Communion: when possible, it is highly recommended that you distribute Communion in the hand instead of in the mouth as it is much easier to avoid contact via the hand. Additionally, please clean the pyx after visiting the facility (suggestion: spray Lysol and let dry, and then wash with dish soap and water). And finally, if you are uncomfortable visiting a facility and/or distributing Communion, even if you have no symptoms, please let the parish staff know so that we can either find an alternate or inform the facility.*
