Tip of the Week

"For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." Mt 11:30

Jesus promises us that when we follow Him (discipleship), our burdens will be light; we can ultimately find true rest in His presence. As we journey through life, we are called to notice that it is **never too late** to accept Jesus' invitation to "Come to me." It is **never too late** to answer the call to experience true rest.

Try these tips to find the rest that we so deeply desire:

- Be available for rest on Sunday, the day Jesus Resurrected.
 Attend Mass in person or online; afterwards, try to make it a true day of rest by doing something together as a family, perhaps, connecting with those who don't have families, or having an old fashioned "Sunday dinner." More summertime activities here.
