What to do with created classes – archiving, copying, deleting

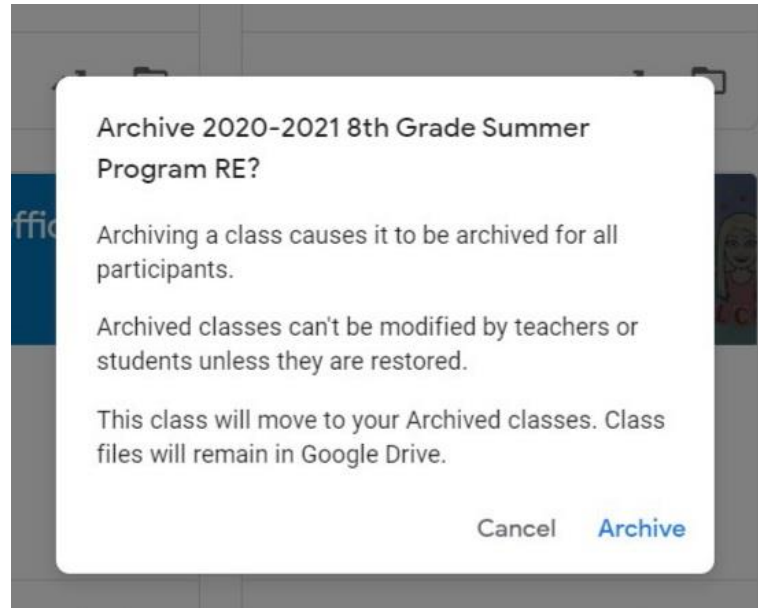




Archiving

Important Points:

- Archiving preserves the class exactly as is, i.e., you can see the list of students, the posted assignments, comments, etc.
- It is reversible, so you can “unarchive” it



- Students can still access an archived class but they cannot edit or add anything to it

Copying

Important Points:

- Copying a class clears the roster so the students from the class you are copying are removed (you are starting “fresh”)
- All assignments you posted in the prior class along with their content are preserved as drafts

Copy class

Create a new class with copied topics and classwork items. Rosters and announcements won't be copied.

Important Points:

- Cannot be reversed
- The files you created for the class will still be in your Drive (Google Docs, Forms, etc.)

Is the attendance feature available yet for the free version?

Unfortunately it isn't, and is only available for Business Plus and Enterprise (the two more expensive editions).

Do we need a new license for the new school year?

When you register a Google Workspace (G Suite) account and opt for a paid subscription, you are billed monthly and can downgrade or upgrade to a different version. If you are on an annual plan, you'd have to wait for that annual renewal date to come up to make a change. If you are wondering about renewing your domain name registration, that is typically annual.





How many can use on one Parish account?

Google Workspace for Nonprofits and nonprofit discounts on Business Standard and Business Plus have a maximum limit of 2,000 users. There is no minimum or maximum user limit for discounted Enterprise plans.

How can I block students from sharing the screen or muting a catechist?

Unfortunately, we do not have this option – only the education versions (available only to schools) have this capability.

Google Workspace Application Process

✨ You must have a Gmail account to fill out an application ✨

Step 1

[Go to the site](#) and click 'Get Started', and make sure you have the following available:

Parish mission statement and parish tax exempt number (You will need a Gmail account to fill this out). *Very important: the tax ID must be in this format:
12-3456789

Step 2

You should receive notification within a few days to two weeks of submitting the application. (Most people find it takes closer to just a few days.) You will be notified via email.

Step 3

When you receive notification, you will receive an email that tells you to 'Activate Products' - be sure to do that! The product you are activating is G Suite. You have a two week trial period for G Suite, after which you will "officially" be using G Suite for Nonprofits.
