Good Morning –

As the years have passed, we are at a point in our ministry where adjustments and additions need to be made to support the liturgical ministries for Mass and other Pastoral Ministry & Activities. Since 2010 our ministries have grown and because of age and infirmity, a number of our ministers have “retired”, deservedly so. We are at a critical point again to develop our ministries and deepen our ranks for service to the parish family. Yes, there is a need, reviewing the liturgical ministers listing in the bulletin, you can see the regular holes in the schedule, and for some doing more than their fair share, scheduled almost weekly.
