

ST. BONIFACE & ST. MEINRAD PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING

August 20, 2018

The Pastoral Council of the parish family St. Boniface & St. Meinrad parishes met on Aug. 20, 2018 at 6:00 pm at St. Boniface Parish Center. The following people were present: Fasther Anthony, Amy Dilger, Kelly Greulich, Romilda Pund, Pearl Gelarden, Sally Gravatte, Faith Schaefer, Jan Gogel and Pam Davis.

Kelly Greulich opened the meeting with the Connected in the Spirit prayer.

Jan gave an update on the cemetery fence – section C – it will match the rest of the fence. Lightning in St. Boniface church – Helming Brothers said our protection is not up to date – need two more ground wires - \$22,000. Lightning has struck four times in four years – we have \$5,000 deductible. It was discussed about having a meeting before Mass sometime to talk about future decisions.

Pearl – 11 students will be confirmed on November 18, 2018 at 10:30 am at St. Meinrad Catholic Church. Faith Formation for pre-school – 6th grade will be from 6:00 – 7:15 pm. TRG groups will visit five different sites for Catholic Social Ministry (CSM) three times a year. May 4 and 5, 2019 fifteen second graders will receive First Communion. Safe and Sacred Certification is in Process.

The minutes were read by Romilda. Corrections were made and approved by Pam Davis and seconded by Sally Gravatte.

Approved all financial reports from February, 2018 thru June, 2018. Sally Gravatte made the motion and Pam Davis seconded.

Sally Gravatte made a motion to approve St. Meinrad Parish budget and Kelly Greulich seconded it.

Kelly Greulich made a motion to approve the Faith Formation schedule and Sally Gravatte seconded it.

Future meeting dates for Pastoral Council will be Monday, September 17, 2018, Monday, October 15, 2018 and Monday, November 19, 2018.

Father Anthony recommended deadline dates for the following: February – Council approved budget for next year; March – Commission schedule for next year; April – Faith Formation schedule for next year.

Pam Davis reported on Pastoral Ministries and Activities – going well.

Service and Outreach – Faith Schaefer reported they are filling the pantry at Chrisney Elementary School with canned goods, etc.

20/20 Vision – Sally Gravatte had nothing new.

Liz Hatcher is working on getting musicians and cantors.

Commission meetings were approved by Romilda Pund and seconded by Pam Davis.
