



**Pastoral Council  
Minutes  
November 19, 2018**

The Pastoral Council of the parish family St. Boniface Parish & St. Meinrad Parish met on November 19, 2018 at 6:00 pm at St. Boniface Parish Center. Commission minutes, cumulative financial reports, 545 Bash/Spencer County Bicentennial Celebration and St. Meinrad Summer Picnic financial reports, and the affirmation of future meeting dates were approved. Motion made by Sally Gravatte, Pam Davis seconded.

Father Anthony reported that St. Boniface monthly offerings are down \$750 - \$1,000. St. Meinrad is up. Kelly Greulich contacted Jeff Mohr for Heritage, Fundraising & Marketing – Jeff needs more info.
