CELEBRATING SACRAMENTS

Marriage Couples desiring to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage are to contact the pastor a minimum of six months before the proposed wedding date and be a registered parishioner. To request an appointment with the pastor, and to complete the "Getting Married? Start Here!" online registration, visit www.smatholic.church/marriage

Wedding Anniversary Couples desiring to receive a blessing for significant marriage anniversaries at Mass or to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving must contact the pastor a minimum of six months before the proposed date and be a registered parishioner.

First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion In anticipation for receiving sacraments, children come together with their peer group in class sessions offered for this particular focus of sacramental formation and preparation. Children who receive home-based or time-release Faith Formation for First Reconciliation, and other Sacraments of Initiation, at another parish, besides their home parish, are required to meet with the pastor of their home parish at the beginning of their formation in anticipation for celebrating the next sacrament in their journey of encounter Christ in the Sacraments of the Church. Families are to provide in writing, from the pastor of the parish providing an alternative Faith Formation Program, the pastor's written consent, along with a copy of the materials outlining the child's sacramental preparation, that he is aware the child is preparing to receive a sacrament from him, even though the child belongs to another ecclesial (parish) community where the child and their family are registered as parishioners and visibly living out their Catholic Faith. Our goal is to keep in mind the child's best interest for lifelong formation and living out their sacramental life in the church. **More info @** www.sbcatholic.church/sacraments
