

God forgives, He gives Israel the chance to celebrate the Passover, with gratitude remembering the great deeds. Reconciliation is also at the heart of the story Jesus tells in today's Gospel. The story of the Prodigal Son is the story of Israel and of the human race including us - every believer.

By Baptism, we are made "a new creation," but when we sin, we become like the Prodigal Son, leaving the Father's house, squandering our inheritance in sin and pride. Lost in sin, we deprive ourselves from the grace of Baptism. But when we come to our senses, the Lord restores our identity – true sons and daughters.

Only God can remove the reproach and restore the divine sonship. Only He can free us from the slavery to sin. God wants not slaves but beloved children. He longs to call each of us "My son," to share His life with us, to tell us: "Everything I have is yours."

The Father's words of longing and compassion still come to His prodigal children in the Sacrament of Penance. Reconciled like Israel, we take our place at the table of the Eucharist, the homecoming banquet of the Father. We taste the goodness of the Lord, as we sing in today's Psalm, rejoicing that we who were dead are found alive again.

Reconciliados como Israel, tomamos nuestro lugar en la mesa de la Eucaristía, el banquete de regreso del Padre. Saborearemos la bondad del Señor, mientras cantamos en el Salmo de hoy, regocijándonos de que los muertos sean hallados vivos de nuevo.
