



Dear Parishioners:

I want to first thank each of you for continued support of St. Angela Merici especially during these unprecedented times. The challenges brought about by COVID 19 were unforeseen, yet we as a parish community were able to unite and are where we are today because of your sustaining spiritual and financial support.

We continually strive to be good and transparent stewards with your financial contributions and as such want to provide you with some of the fundamental information from our 2019 Fiscal Year. Below illustrates the income and expenses breakdown for the 2019 Fiscal Year which runs from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.




### Expense Breakdown



Your continued support enables us to operate and maintain the church, Parish Life Center, and Parish offices. Your contributions also enable the Parish to provide faith formation and sacramental classes, grow our ministries, and pay the salaries of the Parish staff. Although several of our ministries were significantly impacted with the onset of COVID in March, our parish staff worked very diligently to continue to provide spiritual support to our parishioners in new and innovative ways. Staff members were asked to drastically cut budgets and parishioners stepped up to bridge the gap resulting from the lack of the in-pew offertory. The parish was also granted a PPP loan to assist with costs associated with payroll during the first phase of economic relief from COVID-19. As you can see from the graphs following, there was a significant focus on reduction of expenses.

Even with these challenges there were 719 children from PreK to 12<sup>th</sup> grade enrolled and active in Faith Formation. St. Angela was also blessed to have 71 children receive their First Communion, 78 high schoolers go through Confirmation, and we welcomed 12 new members to the faith through RCIA. We were also blessed to officiate over 43 baptisms, 14 weddings, and 7 funerals.



St. Angela Merici remains a strong parish of over 1800 families participating in multiple ministries. We are looking forward to your further investment in the spiritual and financial growth of this community as we await the launch of our Built on Faith Capital Campaign in 2021.

I appreciate the trust you place in me to ensure the financial stability of the Parish, and do not take this trust lightly. The members of the Finance Council and I continue to monitor the operational expenses of the Parish and meet at least once every two months to ensure the Parish's financial viability. We remain confident that with your continued gifts of time, talent, and treasure we will continue to meet both the operational and spiritual needs of our growing Parish, and ensure that St. Angela Merici remains a financially healthy, warm, and welcoming place of worship.

In closing, I am deeply grateful for your support of our Parish, and I look forward to working together with you to fulfill the mission of St. Angela Merici.
