Ever since my dear mother passed always, there is no day passing by, without thinking of her. Mothers are very special. Therefore, I would like to invite you to pray a novena for our mothers. What is a novena? It is nine days of prayer, which we get from the Acts of the Apostles. It was nine days from the Ascension of the Lord to Pentecost, when Jesus commended the Apostles to stay in the Upper Room and to pray. This became a model for many other spiritual exercises and nine days of prayer, known as novena. Beginning with the Mother's Day, May 10th, we will pray a novena (nine Masses and prayers) for all of our mothers, living and deceased. If you want to include your mother, grandmother, or godmother in our novena, please, add her name to the list on the front porch of the Parish office. You may leave your donation in the drop box.

On the four sides of the cross are the following:

The lamp of knowledge (on our current uniform - it will remain - it's tradition) The soaring eagle (no explanation needed)
The Blessed Mother (for our devotion to her and to pay homage to the original name of the Resurrection school building - Our Lady of Victories - and the "roots" of our beloved school)

The light house (to denote our location - on the Coast and near the cherished Round Island Light House - and a symbol of the Diocese of Biloxi).
