## Update on Fr. Michael Callanan:

We received a phone call this week from the priest who is overseeing Fr. Callanan's care at Maryknoll in New York. It has been determined that Fr. Michael will not be able to return to Annunciation, as his care situation continues to be fragile. He will be entering into what is called a Second Novitiate. The intent is to allow him to focus solely on his well-being without any outside distractions. He will not be isolated—just the opposite—he will be in the company of men in the same surroundings who will be dedicated to prayer and their relationship with God. Toward that end, we have been asked to cease any further communication with Fr. Michael, as cards, letters and any correspondence will distract him from what is now the primary mission of his priesthood. He, likewise, will not communicate with us for the time being. The staff at Maryknoll who have been treating Fr. Michael believe that this is the best direction for him at this time and he is in agreement. If conditions change for him, we will be notified and will, of course, pass this along to you. Your continued prayers for Fr. Callanan will surely aid him in this new chapter of his life.

## Fr. Eugene's Retirement Gift:

With Fr. Eugene's rapidly approaching retirement, we've received a number of requests from parishioners regarding either a parish or a personal gift for him. We recently were informed by the Archdiocese that he will receive a stipend from them toward the purchase of a new car—monies meant primarily to cover insurance, taxes and other car buying-associated costs; but no funds for an actual purchase itself. Therefore, it seems fitting that the parish offer him what we can for a new (or at least "newer") car.
