What is Totus Tuus?

Totus Tuus was Saint Pope John Paul II's apostolic motto. It is a Latin phrase meaning "totally thine" and expressed in his consecration to Mary.

A team of college age missionaries (2 men, 2 women) are prepared to engage and help the students learn about the faith.

This program strives to teach the faith in a fun and interactive way so that the students see their faith through a new lens and long to live it out. Some of the big attractions for the incoming 1st-6th grade students are the fun bible story skits, dynamic games, and the human sundae. On Friday of the camp, one of the Totus Tuus missionaries' volunteers to have the kids pour sundae toppings on them before the water balloon fight and slip'n slide held at Fr. Rick's back yard.

Will there be any adults present with the Totus Tuus team and students?

Yes, the youth director and numerous volunteers will be on site assisting with the students.

Where will the program take place?

The program will take place at Christ the King Catholic School. Parents are asked to walk their elementary school age children into the building.

How the elementary students are kept engaged?

The Totus Tuus team teaches them songs, performs skits and plays games with the students. Also, the students are rewarded for their good behavior on Friday with a water balloon toss and water fight. It is also a Totus Tuus tradition to have a human sundae. The students are asked to bring sundae toppings to pour on top of one Totus Tuus Team members on Friday.

How are the Junior and Senior High students engaged?

The evening junior high and high school program is lots of fun and engaging. The missionaries deliver a dynamic lineup of faith witness talks, skits, and visual presentations to motivate and experience the teens' faith outside of the classroom setting.
