Centennial News: Bishop Jeanmard and another priest were involved in a car accident in Baton Rouge in 1945. They were brought to Our Lady of the Lake Hospital in Baton Rouge for treatment. The bishop was so impressed with the care at this hospital staffed by the Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady that he began efforts immediately to have these Sisters open a hospital in Lafayette. His efforts came to completion on August 1, 1949 when the Sisters opened Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital a few blocks from the Cathedral. The Sisters began the hospital with fifty beds. Our Lady of Lourdes expanded steadily over the years and is now a major medical treatment center for the entire region.
