Quelques paroles de Monsieur le Cure

I am, quite literally, banging out a quick reflection on Monday morning right before I leave for retreat. Today is the feast day of St. Jerome, the great Biblical scholar.

The other night, Bob Marcell, after the Come Lord Jesus meeting with the students, commented on how much he personally enjoyed the reflection and discussion on the following Sunday's gospel with the young people. His remark made my day for a number of reasons.

I, too, enjoy the reflection and discussion on the gospel. Last year and this these young people are opening my eyes to a new and refreshing view of the gospel. They also give me some very good ideas for the next Sunday's sermon.

I have tried to communicate to these delightful young people the Church's understanding that the Holy Spirit who inspired the authors of the Bible is the same Holy Spirit that inspires us when we read the Bible.

And as the Holy Spirit provides for different people and their needs, so it is possible that each of us in the group on Wednesday evening will experience a different message from the same gospel passage. The important thing is that we understand that which the Holy Spirit is attempting to reveal to us for our own good.

Like Bob, I am delighted that the young people in our parish are growing in their appreciation of the Bible. Although, as I did last week, I sometimes slip into my teacher mode and try to teach some aspect of the passage before us, and shame on me for doing that, most of the time I do try to encourage them to express the message they are receiving at the moment.

Fr. Conley Betrand, the founder of the Come Lord Jesus movement, has a great love for the Bible, the living Word of God. His commentaries on the Sunday Gospels, which are available to the facilitators, are an expression of some sixty years of praying with the Bible.

There are a few Come Lord Jesus groups in our parish. These adults follow the same format for the meetings as our young people and children are using on Wednesdays. Some have been meeting weekly for decades.

This is something that you and your friends may want to explore. You do not need a priest to form the group. The material for forming a group is readily available and there are people willing to help get you started. All you need to do is contact the Come Lord Jesus office in Lafayette. You can email me or telephone the rectory for the number.

A weekly commitment may be overwhelming at this time in your life, but you may want to think about starting a group to meet weekly during the Advent Season or during Lent.
