This Sunday's Holy Scriptures

Exodus 17:8-13
2 Timothy 3:14, 4:2
Luke 18:1-8

FOCUS: Perseverance in prayer and fidelity to God's ways lead us to the kingdom. Endurance runners need a great deal of perseverance. They cannot expend all their energy at the beginning or they won't be able to complete the race. Nor can they run the race without the proper training, fuel and clear direction as to the route. We, too, need a tremendous amount of perseverance to run a race of good faith. Prepared by sacraments, fueled by grace and headed toward Jesus, we can reach the kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

In the first reading, Moses needs help in keeping his hands raised so that Joshua will be victorious. Saint Paul reminds Timothy to remain faithful to what he has learned. In the Gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the persistent widow to remind the disciples to *pray always without becoming weary*.
