### SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus commands his disciples to go beyond the Torah of Moses, that among other things, orders: "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth." This specifies that a limb one has lost is to be compensated by another's limb, one's life for another's. This is popular called "*lex talionis* (law of "such/equivalent"); a damage requires only an equivalent damage as payment. The law curtailed the impulse for unlimited vengeance and unnecessary bloodshed.

Jesus goes beyond the *lex talionis*; not only should the harm not be returned, but the person should do good to his enemies. Jesus is here setting a new pattern of life. Just as his Father pardons and continues to shower the people with his blessings despite their betrayal, so must they do to their enemies. Jesus himself sets an example: dying on the cross, he asks his Father to forgive his killers for "they know not what they do" (Lk 23:34).

Jesus words are difficult to accept in a society where revenge and violence are felt almost everywhere. Does the love of enemies mean passivity so that the Christian does not do anything to curtail the injustices going on around? This is not what Jesus means. In fact, he is teaching his followers to actively "resist" their enemies. The better move is to conquer the hearts of one's enemies. The they are "eliminated" because they have ceased to be enemies; they have become friends.

If we apply "an eye for an eye" or "a tooth for a tooth," we will soon become a society of blind or toothless people. Jesus is giving us a way out of the vicious cycle: love your enemies. Love is always creative; violence is destructive.

## Nominations to the Parish Pastoral Council

***“O Lord, You read the hearts of all people. Make known to us which of these you choose for your apostolic ministry...They then drew lots between them. The choice fell to Matthias, who was added to the eleven Apostles.” Acts 1:24-26***

With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we will begin the nominations for members to sit in our Parish Council. The nomination process will begin on the weekend of February 25 and 26. Only REGISTERED parishioners may nominate or be nominated.

Nominees must also participate in the sacramental life of the Church and be 18 years of age or older. Parish Pastoral Council members must serve a term of two years and attend monthly meetings. As a consultative body, the Parish Pastoral Council is responsible to the pastor, assisting and supporting him in his leadership role. It also recognizes the varied gifts of parish members and invites them to an active leadership role in the parish.

The Council should be an important means by which the pastor will hear the voice of the parish. In deliberations and consultation with the pastor, the council helps to unite the pastor and parishioners. Together they discern the pastoral needs of the parish and ways in which those needs can be addressed.
