#### GODPARENTS AND SPONSORS:

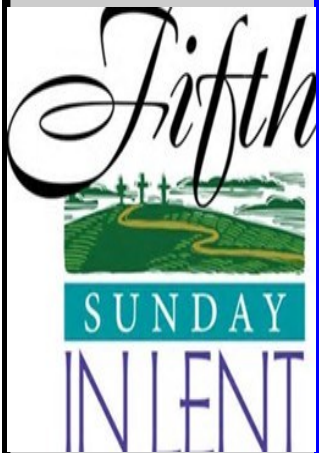

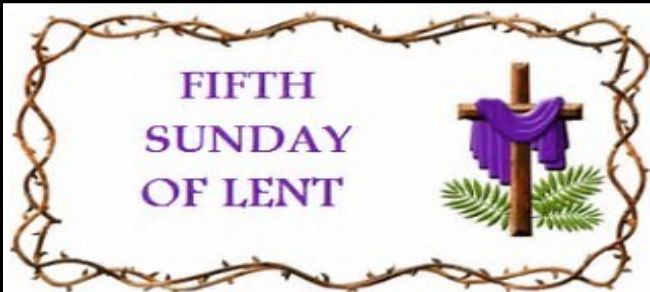

## FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT



### DEATH AS THE REVELATION OF GOD'S GLORY

Martha speaks for humanity in her conversation with the Son of God. The issue is death and its purpose, which Jesus explains as a venue for God to show his glory for those who believe in him.

Martha's anguish in talking to Jesus about the passing of his brother underscores the universal helplessness of humanity in the face of death. At the passing of a loved one, we can only cry and whine. But this experience of our nothingness can become the turning point of our lives when we manage to surrender ourselves to Jesus.

Only Jesus can claim with authority: "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." Death reminds us that we remain finite and fragile creatures. Our salvation is to bow down before God, to believe in him, which salvation is to bow down before God, to believe in him, which means beginning a relationship of dialogue, opening ourselves to Jesus that he may live in us.

When we grieve over the death of our loved ones, let us allow Jesus' promise of eternal life to echo in our hearts, give us comfort and prepare us to face our own end, knowing that through our surrender to Jesus, we will manifest his glory.
