# PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD



**WE ARE NOT ENOUGH.** Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion commemorates Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. This event is pregnant with significance in the life of the Lord; its implication is likewise immense for the disciples. It is a life-changing moment, a defining act of submission. Riding a donkey, Jesus makes a deliberate and painful decision to traverse the path to his death.

The Father has made Jesus complete. Obeying the Father's will assures Jesus the completion of his identity as the Son of God and as the Savior of humanity.

What makes us complete? Human relationships, however noble, loving and self-giving, will always be inadequate. In fact, people who are deeply in love can attest to the sublime truth that no matter how much of themselves they give to one another, there will always be something they cannot offer, something beyond their reach—undefinable, imperceptible. It is because we are not enough for our dear ones. We are not enough for the people we serve and love. We are not enough for others even if we have given them everything we have got. Parents are not enough for their children, spouses for each other. Friends are not enough, achievements are not enough, even the whole world is not enough.

Jesus knows this. The "hosanna" and the praises are not enough. He himself is not enough for the people. So he gives his life, so that whatever is needed, whatever is lacking, may be granted by the Father, filled and fulfilled.

This Holy Week, let us rid ourselves of the clutter of life, ride the donkey of humility and enter our own Jerusalem, knowing and believing that God alone can fill us and make us complete.
