SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

LEARNING FROM THE MARTYRS

"I want to see God!" Teresa de Cepeda y Ahumada was so inspired by the lives of the martyr's death (cf Vida, 1,4). Although she would not die a martyr, this girl's desire changed her life completely. She would become an influential figure in the Catholic Church, bringing about reform by her example and writings. We now venerate this woman as Sr. Teresa of Avila.

Sr. Teresa's experience shows how the lives of the martyrs, ordinary people who shed their blood in testimony to their faith, shape the Church. It is said that the Church is watered by the blood of the martyrs. The First Reading attests to this. Phillip, one of the seven deacons chosen by the Apostles (cf Acts 6:5), was succeeding in his proclamation of the Good News in Samaria. This was the first fruit of the persecutions experienced by the early Christians.

Why would martyrdom, a seeming show of weakness and defeat, cause a positive effect upon the faithful?

The Gospel provides the answer. "If you love me, you will keep my commandments". Jesus declares that authentic love is expressed not by words but by deeds. "Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me". Only through generous and faithful self giving and through obedience to God's will is true love shown.

In the Second Reading, Peter exhorts Christians to "be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope", "keeping your conscience clear". To suffer for doing good is better than for doing evil.

Moreover, in the Gospel, Jesus promises "another Advocate" Christ is our Advocate and Mediator before God, yet upon his ascension he sends someone to be on our side—the Holy Spirit. God's Spirit accompanies, consoles, protects and defends us. The Spirit casts away our fears and empowers us to make a stand for what is right and good.

I just learned a Chamorro phrase that best reflect our efforts to establish the Adoration Chapel at Our lady of the Blessed Sacrament Church. I am writing this letter to express my most sincere appreciation and gratitude for your contribution towards the success of the opening the OLBS Adoration Chapel. Without your dedication and sacrifice for the Lord, our chapel wouldn't be opened 24hrs a day.

Summer is also near and many people are planning on going on vacations away from Guam. Therefore, I wanted to remind you again about your role as guardians so that we can continually keep the adoration open 24 hours a day. Through knowing our role, and following these simple guidelines it will help all guardians do their duty with peace.

Here are some reminders for our role as guardians:

- 1) Please establish a list of people (preferably family and friends) who are willing to be a substitute for you if you are not able to make your hour. Out of courtesy, please give people on your list, chapel committee members and/or group hour leaders at least **24 HOURS NOTICE** if you are not able to make it.
- 2) If you know you will be leaving off-island or won't be making your adoration hour ahead of time to please ask your family and friends first. If you are having a difficult time, then you can contact your guardian hour leader for assistance. The absolute last person to call will be Marcia, Joe Quinata or myself, Fr. Marvin.
- 3) If you know you're coming down with a cold or other illness prior to your day of adoration, please find your substitute right away. The earlier you secure your substitute the better for people to help find coverage.
- 4) Continue to invite friends, family, and even co-workers to become guardians especially for the early morning hours.
