SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY BECAUSE "PERSONS" MATTER

Perhaps no teaching that the Catholic Church holds dear can be as perplexing and confounding as her doctrine on the Trinity — that there are three Persons in one God. That very formulation alone, common sense tells us, is problematic. "How can that be?" many have asked, and many more have tried to answer. But as we realize, it is a truth that human logic can never completely comprehend and human words can never fully express. The Trinitarian character of God will always be a mystery.

But that does not stop us from trying. Yes, the Trinity is difficult to teach, especially in the contemporary culture where Christianity is being relegated to the sidelines. We would rather stick to the simpler "essentials." God is good and loving; God came down to this world to redeem us; God remains with us all our days.

Why bother with three persons in one God?

First, the Trinity is not something the Church invented but a truth God himself revealed. While the term itself does not appear anywhere in the Bible, the reality of the Trinity is nevertheless attested by it. And this can be gleaned from God's interactions with his people, in different times revealing various facets of himself. It is through such thousands of years of relating with God that we have come to understand, albeit incompletely, and through his guidance and grace, the complexity of who God is. God as Trinity is something we have experienced, and it is at the foundation of the very life and history of the Church. Perhaps that is why the Apostle Paul was able to mark his greeting with the Trinitarian formulation we still use today: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Cor 13:13).

Second, we are made in the image of this Trinitarian God. Thus, we find in God the secrets of our own persons—our purpose and essence. And what we find in God is this; that as he is, so are we created out of and for love. In God we find three Persons locked in an eternal gaze toward each other, an endless and omnipotent exchange of divine love.

CCD and Confirmation Registration

In the coming weeks we will have announce the dates of our early registration for the upcoming school year 2017-18. In the meantime if your child is going to receive the Sacrament of First Holy Communion and Confession you must have all the necessary paperwork before turning in a registration form:

1) Your parents/Guardians must be a registered parishioner at OLBS. They must be regular mass attendees at the parish. Any other situation must go through Fr. Marvin for approval. Forms are available in the front of the Church

2) Copy of Birth Certificate

3) Copy of Baptismal Certificate

- especially for those who were baptized outside of OLBS.

- If your child was baptized at OLBS and you do not have a copy of your child's baptismal certificate then you need to request for one at the Parish office. Cost is \$5.00.

For Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation you will need the following and turn in the necessary paperwork:

1) Your parents/Guardians must be a registered parishioner at OLBS. They must be regular mass attendees at the parish. Any other situation must go through Fr. Marvin for approval.

2) Copy of Birth Certificate

3) Copy of Baptismal and First Holy Communion Certificate

- especially for those who were baptized outside of OLBS.

- If your child was baptized at OLBS and you do not have a copy of your child's baptismal/Holy Communion certificate then you need to request for one at the Parish office. Cost is \$5.00 each.

MANDATORY SEX ABUSE WORKSHOP

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to inform you that all parishioners in active ministry or would like to serve in a public ministry at the parish must attend a sex abuse/safe environment. I recently attended a priest meeting and the task force chairperson along with the Fr. Jeff San Nicolas have stated that it is mandatory. I apologize for any confusion or misunderstanding when I first announced about this workshop when it was held at the parish. Some have asked if it's okay to not attend the meeting if they have already attended a similar workshop with the Department of Education. I asked that question to the task force chairperson and was told that even though a parishioner attended a workshop with the DOE they still need to attend the Archdiocesan Workshop.

Those who must attend are all people who are active in public ministry and those who especially work with children. This includes Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Altar Server Leaders, CCD/Confirmation Coordinators and Teachers, Parish Council. If you have already attended a workshop than you do not need to attend another one. If you have no attended a workshop there are several opportunities for you to attend.
