FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



The Heart of Jesus's Strategy is Prayer and Praise

Commonly referred to by Bible scholars as the "Johannine touch" in Matthew because the style of Jesus' words in it reminds us of the flow in John, the Gospel shows the heart of Jesus' strategy against the malice and snares of evil in his works. Jesus' strategy against the malice and snares of evil in his works. Jesus confronts and defeats the power of evil by effective prayer and praise that he offers to the heavenly Father, who knows all is over all.

Jesus' prayer and praise to his Father give us glimpses into what our own prayer can be:

(1) **God is Father.** Jesus insists on calling God "Father" not once but five times in his prayer. Jesus makes us realize that the spirit of prayer enables us to keep in mind: God has love and concern for each one of us. We are not just God's creatures but also God's beloved children.

(2) **Human wisdom and learning can be the culprit.** Without prayer and introspection, we tend to join the bandwagon that blames God for almost everything that goes wrong—for so many poor people (instead of the selfish ways of some); for destructive floods, avalanche, and landslides (instead of greedy capitalists, exploitation of nature); for the continuing state of war and violence (instead of military aggression of powerful nations dominating the use of developing countries' resources).

(3) **The way of Jesus, the Son, is the revelation of God's way.** Jesus' way is a way of mysteries unveiling the manner of divine action and gifting: the incarnation teaches that broken humanity is part of God's equation of action; the paschal mystery of the Church reveals that God's goodness always has a communal dimension; the Eucharist makes known that in God's project grace builds on nature.

(4) **God's method is "being with."** God who did not spare his Son Jesus from suffering and death, does not magically erase all pain and sorrow. These are part of the wages of sin in this passing world. However, God shows his love and care through Jesus who is divine mercy and compassion. Jesus joins us in our humanity—experiencing everything that is human, except sin. Earthly life with its ups and downs becomes meaningful because we need not go through it in a desolate way. Life's yoke is a double yoke—we carry it, and with us is the Spirit of Jesus who has walked through all that life can offer.

YEAR OF REPARATION

Archbishop Michael J. Byrnes has proclaimed a Year of Reparation for the Archdiocese of Agana that began on July 6, 2017 and will continue until the Solemnity of Pentecost on May 20, 2018. There will be various activities during the Year of Reparation, all focusing on three pillars: FASTING, PRAYING AND GIVING.

The Year of Reparation will emphasize on the healing grace of prayer, penance, almsgiving and the redemptive power of Jesus Christ.

We believe that our prayers, our corporal and spiritual acts of mercy can bring healing to the hurting and can begin to repair the wounds of the Body of Christ. It is an indication of God's providential will that we embark on this campaign of prayer, fasting and almsgiving in the midst of the 100th anniversary of the apparitions at Fatima.

One of the important activities during the Year of Reparation, is that a "Traveling Monstrance" will go from parish to parish for exposition of and devotion to the Holy Eucharist. Our parish will have the Traveling Monstrance during our Healing Mass on July 14, 2017.
