## THE “YES” PROVEN IN ACTION

People receive God's will in different ways. In the end, however, the responses boil down to just one: either obey God's will or reject it. We see this in the parable of the Two Sons. One obeys the wishes of the father; the other does not. What makes their contrasting responses dramatic is that both actually go against their own will. The first son goes against his will by changing it to the father's will but later reneges on it. It is the first son, who ultimately aligns his will to the father's who is found pleasing to the father.

In giving this parable, Jesus relates it to the Pharisees, experts of the Law, who fail to carry out God's will. Jesus also means the parable for sinners. They recognize God's mercy and forgiveness in the person of Jesus, and are more receptive to Jesus' words and teachings. They initially disobeyed God because of their sinful lives, but salvation is theirs when they open their hearts and minds to the good news of salvation proclaimed by Jesus.

The First Reading stresses the greater responsibility on the part of people who are knowledgeable about God's commands. When the righteous man sins, his sins is grave in the sense that he knowingly commits something evil before God. His culpability and responsibility are even aggravated because he is not an unknowing or unwitting sinner. On the other hand, God

has a soft heart for sinners. A good deed by a sinner who converts is greatly rewarded. In the words of the prophet Ezekiel, "None of the crimes he has committed shall be remembered against him" (18:22).

The Gospel is both a word of hope and an admonition. Hope is given to sinners who change from their situation of sin to a life of obedience to God's will. God does not cease to call to conversion those who stray from the path of righteousness. A highway is left open for them to pass. But the Gospel also admonishes those who are righteous to stay on the path of righteousness.

## FUNDRAISER FOR NEW AIR CONDITIONER UNITS FOR THE CHURCH AND SOCIAL HALL

### FATHER'S PREVIOUS LETTER:

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to inform you that the Facility Committee of the Parish Council has recently secured a bid from Johnstone Supply to replace 14 air-conditioner split units in the Church and 6 split units in the Social Hall. The units are high quality Fujitsu product. I have already received permission from the Parish Finance Council and approval from the Parish Pastoral Council to begin this air conditioner project for our parish.

The reasons for replacing the existing air-conditioner units in the church and Social Hall are as follows:

- 1) Most of the A/C units in the Church and all of the A/C units in the Social Hall are not energy efficient and do not have the inverter type split units. For this reason, we pay more for our power bill especially when the church and social hall are constantly being used for funerals, CCD and other church functions.
- 2) Most of the A/C units in the Church were purchased in 2007 and all of the A/C Units in the social hall are over 20 years old. We currently have four A/C that are not working in the church and three A/C that are not working well in the Social Hall. This has caused the church and social hall to be unbearably warm when each building is filled to capacity.

To assist the parish in paying for the costs to replace all the Air Conditioner Units, in both the Church and Social Hall, I am humbly asking you, our dedicated families and parishioners of the parish, to Adopt an Air-Conditioner Unit AND/OR make a monthly monetary pledge.

### FOR THE CHURCH:

12—30,000 BTU A/C units will cost \$2,613 each for a total of \$31,356. These A/C are those that run down the middle aisle of the church. **(\*\*SIX UNITS HAVE ALREADY BEEN ADOPTED.)**

\*\*2—24,000 BTU A/C units will cost \$2,121 each and will be placed at the choir area and right side area of the altar. **(\*\*THESE TWO UNITS HAVE ALREADY BEEN ADOPTED).**

### FOR THE SOCIAL HALL:

6—36,000 BTU A/C units will cost \$3,711 each. **(\*\*ONE UNIT HAVE ALREADY BEEN ADOPTED).**
