Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Octave of Easter, the Sunday after Easter. The Feast of Divine Mercy was extended to the entire Catholic Church by Saint John Paul the Great (Pope John Paul II) on April 30, 2000, the day he canonized Saint Faustina. The Octave of Easter has always been special in Church history.

It was on this day that the Resurrected Jesus invited the Apostle Thomas to touch His wounds and to put his hands in His side. The doubt of Thomas was vanquished and he professed his belief in the Risen Christ. Nineteen centuries later, the Risen Lord appeared to a Polish nun, Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska in a series of visions that occurred over a period of eight years. Among those visions, Jesus revealed the Divine Mercy Novena which he asked Saint Faustina to pray over nine days and He asked her to have a painting commissioned of Him, with rays of mercy shining forth from Him. We celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday as a reminder of God's great mercy and love for sinners. We not only need God's mercy for ourselves, we need to extend mercy to others to fulfill our call to be children of the Light. Easter is more than a day, it is a liturgical season. And mercy is more than a one-time event. It is God's way of being in relationship with His people.

Let us confess our sins, and seek God's mercy, in this holy season of Easter, and in all seasons. Pope Francis often shares with us that God never tires of forgiving us, that instead, we tire of asking for forgiveness. May each of you experience God's mercy and love on this Divine Mercy Sunday weekend, and throughout the Easter Season.

Fellowship Sunday Will Resume in May

Fellowship Sunday will resume on **Sunday, May 6, 2018** after both the 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Catholic Pro-Life Committee

At 20 weeks, the unborn baby in the mother's womb already experiences pain in the same way we do. A legislative bill introduced this year (if passed) will ban abortion on unborn babies who have reached 20 weeks gestational age and up. At this age, the abortion method used is referred to as "dismemberment abortion." Forceps are used to tear parts off from the unborn baby's body, limb by limb. A few years back, this bill was introduced but failed to pass for lack of support. Catholic Pro-Life Committee is holding a signature drive for a petition which will provide support for this new legislative bill referred as "**The Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act of 2018.**" Another way you can help support the passage of this Bill is to write a brief letter saying you support Bill No. 232-34 or, come to the Public Hearing at the Guam Legislature on Thursday, April 12 to personally show your support. After all this weekend's masses, Pro-Life volunteers will be outside to get your signatures on this petition. Your support of this Bill and its passage will provide the protection of our unborn babies. Thank you.
