The Disciples Preached Everywhere

The simple folks from Galilee are now sent to proclaim the Gospel. They take over the place of Jesus who has just ascended into heaven.

The Ascension of Jesus is described in just one verse in the Gospel. But it is the turning point for the Apostles to finally work to spread the teachings of Christ. They will prove to the world that Jesus is the Savior of all and that it is right to follow him. Their claims will be supported by the miracles they will perform.

The First Reading also speaks of the Ascension of Jesus. He goes up to heaven after he has appeared to the believers and has made his last minute instructions to the apostles. They will wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit and then they will go and preach. They will give witness starting in Jerusalem and then in the regions of Judea and Samaria and in all corners of the world.

In the Second Reading, Paul encourages the converts in Ephesus to act as expected of Christians. They must be humble, gentle and patient with one another. They should recognize their different gifts, given by the Holy Spirit. They should show unity since they have received the same baptism that comes from the same Lord and that will bring to the same destiny, heaven.

We cannot remain maverick followers of Christ. We have to be active parishioners, spreading the Gospel, communicating God's love and mercy, and contributing to the building up of the Church.

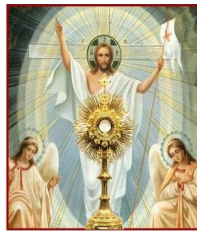
