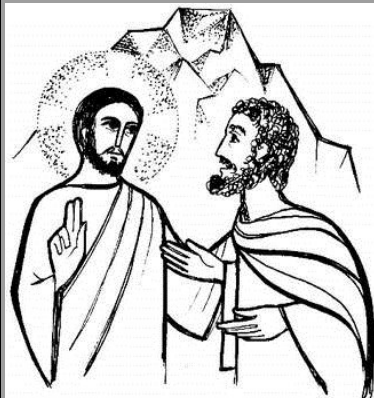
**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:** Please contact the parish office at least six months before the date of the proposed marriage.

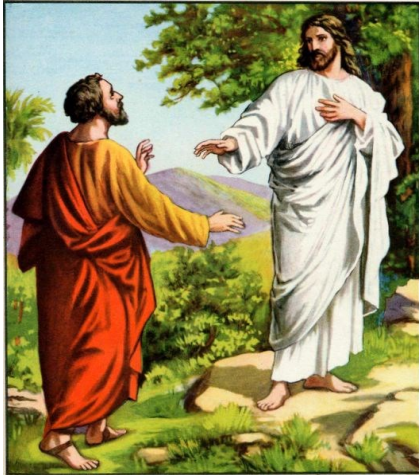

### *Defilement Comes From The Heart*

“All these evils come from within and they defile.”

Jesus speaks these words to the Pharisees who are very strict in the

observance of the Law, especially the laws on purity. They believe that if one does not care about washing food and dishes, one defiles oneself. It is bad religion not to follow this tradition. All Jews must follow the interpretations of the Pharisees to be able to participate in Temple worship and other religious activities.

Jesus reacts to this teaching, regarding it pure hypocrisy. It pays more attention to the external than to the internal. Jesus clarifies what defiles a person. It is not what the person takes in but what comes out of him. Evil does not come from unwashed food and dishes. Evil comes from within, from the heart, from bad attitudes.

What defiles us is what makes us violent and turns us into thieves and murderers. In our catechism, we call it the seven capital sins. To be pleasing to God, we must overcome our negative energies. They can easily surface when provoked and can devastate others.

The Second Reading affirms Jesus' teaching that evil comes from within. The author James exhorts his audience, “Humbly welcome the word that has been planted in you... Be doers of the word.” What brings us to God is loving care for orphans and widows.

The First Reading reminds the Israelites to obey God's commands in order to possess the Promised Land. If they disobey, they will lose the land. God commands that his people love one another as they show their love for God. What defiles them is what destroys their relationship with God and with one another.

### *What is Perpetual Adoration?*

Perpetual Adoration is a Eucharistic devotion whereby members of a given parish unite in taking hours of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament (in most cases, exposed), both during the day and throughout the night, seven days a week.

### *What is Exposition in the Monstrance Preferred?*

To see Jesus visibly present under the appearance of the small white host is much more conducive to intimacy than hidden away in the tabernacle. Moreover, it adds an extra responsibility on the adorers to be sure to be faithful to the hours they are scheduled, since the suggested norm for having Jesus exposed in the monstrance is that there should be at least two adorers present, and He must never be left alone. Could not these words of our Lord be applied today: "Indeed, this is the will of My heavenly Father, that everyone who looks upon the Son, and believes in Him, shall have eternal life. Him I will raise up on the last day."

### *How Does One Spend An Hour Before Jesus Exposed in the Blessed Sacrament?*

This hour Jesus wants you to spend with Him is spent any way you want. You may bring your own prayer books, use the books in the chapel, read the Bible, pray the rosary, or just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God. You may feel that you can't pray well. Don't let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out at a specific time each week to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pleases Him very much and is in itself a prayer of great faith. Please remember that Perpetual Adoration is a parish is not just for a day, a week, a month, or a year. Rather, it is for **ALWAYS**. It is not temporary, but ongoing, lasting, permanent.
