## ADVENT WEEK I:



### *Redemption Is At Hand*

Every Advent season, we recall the two comings of the Lord. The first is the coming of the Messiah born in a manger more than two thousand years ago. The second is the coming of Jesus Christ our Savior at the end of the world.

Many have predicted, and continue to predict, the second coming of Christ. His return is said to presage the end of the world and its destruction. Enslaved by fear, they spend their days uselessly predicting the end time. They dig foxholes and store food and drink in underground bunkers to prepare for the grim end.

Sacred Scripture does not counsel us to prepare for the end by being dominated by fear. Jesus says that we have to welcome the coming of the Son of Man with joy "because your redemption is at hand." We must be prepared at all times. To be ready, Jesus says, is to avoid getting caught up in too much feasting and drinking or being preoccupied with the anxieties of daily life.

The Apostle Paul, writing to the Thessalonians, calls on them to improve their present condition. They will accomplish this if they let their love for one another and for other people grow and become more fervent. God will fortify their hearts so that they will remain holy.

For some people, the coming of the Savior on the first Christmas is only a thing of the past. It is

delightful to dwell upon, but only just like another children's story.

For many of us, instead, Advent is an invitation to reminisce the first Christmas so as to be ready for God's coming to us every day, while we anticipate Christ's return in glory on the final day.

## *Advent Season*

Do you need a break from the hectic pace of the holidays? Advent prayers remind us to stop and take time to focus on what *really* counts this time of year, to prepare for the arrival of our Lord Jesus Christ, both in the Nativity and in His Second Coming as well! During Advent, we await the celebration of Jesus's birth at Christmas while taking stock of our readiness for His return.

The season of Advent (from the Latin "adventus" meaning "coming") precedes Christmas. Starting with the first Sunday closest to November 30th, it marks the first season of the church's Liturgical year.

Pope John Paul II once remarked that he hoped that Advent would be a time for us to strengthen our commitment to our Christian faith. Focusing on the Nativity as well as on the Second Coming reminds us of the timelessness of God's love, and of the importance of showing others His love in our thoughts, words, and actions.

Advent reminds us to give of *ourselves* and to be open to reflecting Christ's presence in our lives, as we think about His being born in a manger in Bethlehem to redeem us from our sins so that we may share Eternal Life with Him in Heaven!

Advent prayers below reflect this spirit:

O God, Who gladdens us by the annual expectation of our Redemption, grant that we, who now receive with joy Your only-begotten Son as our Redeemer, may behold him without fear when He comes as our judge, even the same Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

Stir up our hearts, O Lord, to prepare the ways of Your Only begotten-Son, that we may attain to serve You with purified minds, through His advent. Who with You lives and reigns in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, world without end. Amen.
