PARISH INFORMATION

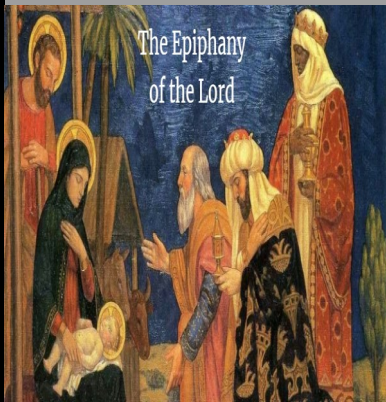

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



Go and Search Diligently for the Child

Epiphany centers on Jesus, the manifestation (*epiphaneia* in Greek) of God in the flesh. For so long the Israelites have been longing for the coming of the Messiah. With the birth of Jesus, the wait is finally over. In Jesus, the face of God the Father is now revealed because Jesus is the Son of God and one with God.

The wise men from the East, searching for the newborn king of the Jews, represent the non-Jewish religions that have come to recognize the birth of someone great. The star that comes out of Judah—alluded to as the future king of the Jews in the prophecy of Balaam (Nm 24:17)—was originally meant for David, but is now applied to the Messiah, the true “King of the Jews.” Jesus’ birth was preceded by consultations from the Scriptures and from nature where this newborn king would be found. As the wise men followed the star, so from nature we can also see the manifestation of God. Through the Sacred Scriptures and through intellectual inference we can find our way to God.

In the Gospel, Matthew highlights the contrast of perspectives: the non-Jews pay homage to Jesus, while the Jews and their leaders, represented by Herod, are indifferent and even hostile to Jesus. In a way, Jesus is rejected by the nation of Israel but accepted by the

Gentiles. The oft-repeated theme of the Israel, as the light to the nations, is now given to Jesus—the true Light of the world. The pilgrimage of the nations to Jerusalem in Isaiah 60 comes to completion with the coming of the wise men from the East.
