## PARISH INFORMATION

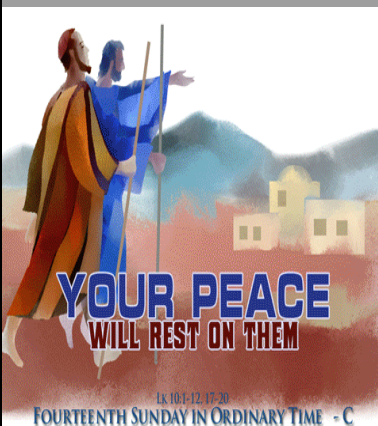

## *Successful Mission*

Besides the Twelve whom he sends to preach to the lost house of Israel, Jesus appoints another group of disciples—the seventy-two (seventy in some manuscripts)—who will later proclaim the Gospel to pagan nations. This group will become the progenitors of different peoples in the world.

Jesus will send the disciples on mission before his ascension into heaven. In the meantime, he is preparing these men by engaging them in a practicum or their first training exercise. They are to set out on a mission of peace, giving shalom to every household and prepared to receive peace in return. They are called to witness to their trust in divine providence by traveling very light. They must learn contentment, remaining in their mission field and not shopping around for more comfortable lodgings.

The disciples are full of joy upon their return from their first salvo of missionary journey. They have witnessed the defeat of the powers of evil. Jesus spends time listening to their success stories and shares their exhilaration and joy.

Lest his disciples start to gloat with pride and self-importance, Jesus directs their joy, from their missionary accomplishments to the assurance of their place in the Kingdom of God.

It is very tempting to read the commissioning of the 72 disciples as a page from the past, and nothing more. Their story reminds us how all baptized Christians belong to the long unbroken chain of modern-day disciples called to continue the mission entrusted to us by the Jesus Christ. We are challenged to move out of our comfort zones and realize that all Christians are essentially missionaries.

“The missionary spirit and the Catholic spirit are one and the same thing” (Pope Pius XII).

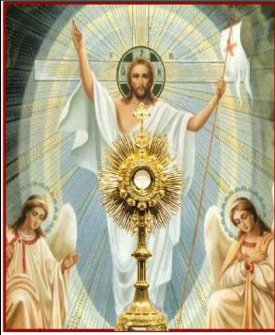

4. If you know that you are coming down with a cold or other illness prior to your day of adoration, please find a substitute right away.
5. Continue to invite friends, family and even co-workers to become guardians.

Please remember that signing up as a guardian for the Chapel is not just for a day, a week, a month, or a year. Rather, it is for always. It is not temporary, but ongoing, lasting, a promise or "Prumesa".
