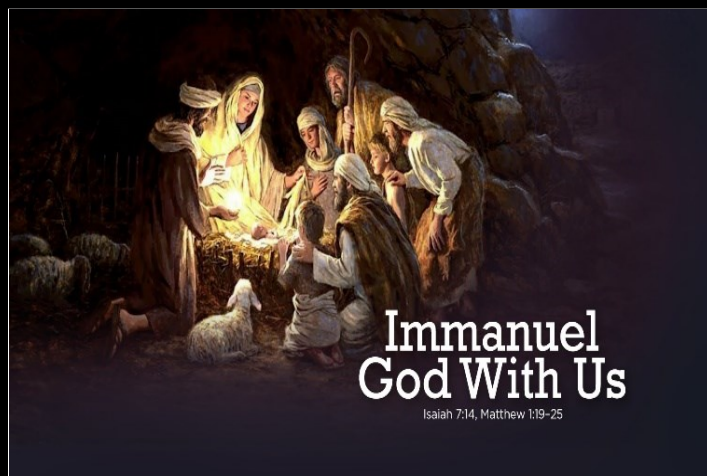

Emmanuel—God Is with Us

The angel tells Joseph that Mary's Son will be named Emmanuel. In Hebrew it is *Immanuel*. *El* is God, *Im* is with, *Immanu* means with us—literally, “with us is God.”

The baby Jesus who is about to be born into the world is God's statement to us. God is telling us, “I am with you.” If God is with you, why worry? Everything will be all right. Your salvation is a hand. God is here to forgive you and take you back. The world will have no power over you. Now you can be good according to God's expectation. Just follow the example of Jesus.

Joseph quietly absorbs what the angel tells him in his dream. When he awakes, he obeys, setting aside his concept of righteousness. He takes Mary into his home. He accepts that nothing is wrong with Mary conceiving a child, because God had done it.

In the First Reading, King Ahaz does not listen when God offers him a sign for the salvation of his people in Jerusalem. Their enemies are about to destroy them. In spite of his non-cooperation, God proceeds with his plan, “The virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel.”

In the Second Reading, Paul reflects on the mystery of the risen Christ. Christ's resurrection calls all Gentiles to faithful obedience for his name's sake. Through Christ, we receive God's grace and our mission to spread the good news.

To feel that God is with us, we need to obey God and recognize God's presence.
