Herod Was Greatly Troubled

Instead of rejoicing, Herod the Great is greatly troubled when he learns that the king of the Jews is born in Bethlehem. The Good News is bad news to him. He is shaken by the Child whom he considers a pretender to his throne. Herod has been in power for 34 years, from 37 BC to 4 BC. (From this reckoning, Jesus' birth is dated in 6 BC.) He has all the support of the emperors of the Roman Empire. He even outlives many of them. That little boy in Bethlehem is no match for him, but Herod is so afraid of him.

Historians tell us that Herod was sick of paranoia. When he saw them as threats to his throne, he murdered Mariamme, his wife, and her two sons. He built the Masada, Herodion, and other structures (now tourist spots in Israel), where he would hide just in case. To gain affection and acceptance from the Jews, because he was an Idumean, not a Jew, therefore of pagan blood, he renovated their Temple in Jerusalem. But that did not work.

Herod will die two years after Jesus' birth, but Jesus will not take over this throne. Jesus has a different purpose. He is not here to govern with impunity, to eliminate suspected power grabbers, to establish an oppressive dynasty like Herod's, but to "shepherd God's people Israel."

The magi correctly interpret the leadership of Jesus. When they find him with the help of a guiding star, they rejoice and prostrate themselves before him and do him homage and offer him precious gifts, to fulfill the prophecy of Trito-Isaiah. They do not see him as a would-be power wielder. They see divinity in him. Jesus manifests himself to them, and to Mary and Joseph and some lowly Judeans.

Jesus reveals himself to all those who approach him without criminal intentions and are willing to be governed and shepherded by him.
