I Did Not Know Him

Though they are cousins, John the Baptist says of Jesus, "I did not know him." There is something to Jesus who pre-existed before John even if the latter was born earlier. John's baptism of sinners is to make Jesus known to the people of Israel. He also baptizes Jesus because he has been made known by the Father who has asked him to do it. When he has accomplished his role, John confesses to know Jesus as the Son of God. John has obeyed the Father, and he encounters his Son in full faith.

Knowing Jesus is a gift of God. It is also a process. When we do the Father's will, we will know Jesus. The Father will draw us to him (cf Jn 6:44). We will no longer be ignorant of Jesus.

Ignorance of Jesus is a sign that we are not doing God's will which is, in our baptism, to renounce Satan and all his works, to commit ourselves to God and his Church. Certainly, we will not know anything about God unless we are committed to him in faith. If we are faithful to our baptismal vows, we will certainly know Jesus.

Isaiah (First Reading) says something about himself, which can be applied to Jesus. He is God's servant. In him, God shows his glory. God formed him as his servant in his mother's womb. Though of lowly origin, he has tall orders from God to restore the tribes of Jacob and to be the light to all nations for the salvation of all.

Paul (Second Reading) know who Jesus Christ is. He confidently says that Jesus is the cause of our sanctification. If ever we are holy, it is because of Jesus. Paul is convinced that everyone is called to be holy in Christ Jesus who is the Lord of the Christians in Corinth and of the apostles.

We have no excuse in not knowing Jesus. In the Eucharist we come to know him more through his words and sacrament.
