# THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD



## *The Fruit of Encounter*

Luke presents Joseph and Mary as particularly faithful to the tradition of their people. They bring the Child Jesus to the Temple in obedience to the law of the Lord, “Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord” (v 23). As the firstborn son (cf Lk 2:7), Jesus is consecrated to the Lord as the law requires (cf Ex 13:2, 12). But there is no requirement that this is to be done in the Temple. Luke probably has in mind the story of Hannah who brings the child Samuel to the sanctuary of the Lord in Shiloh and offers him for sanctuary services.

While holding the Child Jesus in his arms, the old man Simeon blesses God who has filled his promise of salvation — “a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.” Here, we recall the Christmas theme of light shining through the darkness, including the light of the star that leads the Magi to Jesus.

It is because of this light that the Presentation of the Lord is popularly known as “Candlemas” or, in the Philippines, the feast of the *Candelaria*. In the Eastern Churches, it is known as “The Encounter.” The Church has also declared it as *World Day of Consecrated Life*.

During the celebration of the Presentation of the Lord in 2015, Pope Francis dwelt on the theme of encounter: “In the Temple Jesus comes to meet us and we got to meet him. We contemplate the meeting with the elderly Simeon, who represents the faithful expectation of Israel and the exultation of the heart for the fulfillment of the ancient promises. We also admire the meeting with the elderly prophetess Anna, who, on seeing the Child, exults with joy and praises God. Simeon and Anna are the expectation and the prophecy; Jesus is the novelty and the fulfillment: he presents himself to us as the endless surprise of God.”
