# FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



## *A Tremendous Responsibility*

“Salt” and “light” are among the simplest necessities of life, and as it usually happens with man’s basic needs, they are almost always taken for granted. But when food suddenly tastes “saltless,” and when light is suddenly put out, we are brusquely reminded of how much we need them.

When Jesus tells the disciples “You are the salt of the earth,” “You are the light of the world,” he is giving the disciples a tremendous mission that is of paramount importance. They are important to the world as salt and light are important to daily life. And they cannot relegate this mission without dire consequences to the world. Without the Gospel, life would be pale and tasteless and humanity would be without direction.

In truth, it is Jesus who gives “taste” and meaning to human life and preserves it from the destructive influence of sin. It is Jesus who is “light” and enlightens the heart of everyone to receive God’s salvation in faith. But inasmuch as the Christians are branches “grafted” to the Vine (Jesus) and they are “Christ-like,” they too become authentic salt and light.

Someone has come out with a metaphor akin to that of salt and light. Christians, he opines, are “peppers” of life. Though a small fruit, pepper is a condiment that gives “pungence” to food, and by metaphorical extension, to life. It wakes up the palate. People take peppers for granted, but when tempests render them rare and expensive, they miss the “taste” of food. In like manner, believers are called to be “salt and pepper” — “to wake up the world with the light of the Gospel.”

### **ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE:**

#### **Flu Season and the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Outbreak**

Greetings and Peace!

While we are still in the cold and flu season and with the knowledge of the Coronavirus outbreak in China and other parts of the world, we find it necessary to take precautions during mass time.

- ◆ Reception of the Precious Body by hand is recommended at this time.
- ◆ If you are feeling ill or think you may have been exposed to a virus, you should refrain from partaking of the Blood of Christ from the communal chalice.
- ◆ Refrain from offering your hand to others at the sign of peace. A smile and a heartfelt "Peace be with you" should suffice.
- ◆ If you are not comfortable sharing the sign of peace or receiving Holy Communion from the communal chalice for fear of infection, you should feel no pressure to do so.

We must all be aware of such sensitive matters in the intimate life of the Christian community and we should expect that some will refrain from the sign of peace and the communal chalice out of care for our well-being and not out of unkindness or a lack of piety.
