The Samaritan woman in the Gospel often gets bad press. She is living with a man is not her husband. However, Jesus sees the good in her and reaches out to her. Jesus, a Jewish man, talks in public to a woman who is a “foreigner” and belongs to “another religion.” However, she is by no means hardened in heart; she listens to Jesus’ words, receives them with joy, gives him a drink, and even invites her town-mates to come and listen to Jesus.

The beautiful story from John’s Gospel invites a variety of responses. Can we see the good in other people, even those who have been condemned by society? Are we willing to engage them in conversation and maybe even ask them to help us? Do we give people “second chances” when they have made mistakes in life? Is our heart “compassionate” like that of Jesus? Do we accept that Jesus, and Jesus alone, can satisfy the thirst in our heart and fill the void in our life? We pray: “Lord Jesus, our hearts were made for you, and they will not rest until they rest in you.”

Flu Season and the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Outbreak

Greetings and Peace!

While we are still in the cold and flu season and with the knowledge of the Coronavirus outbreak in China and other parts of the world, we find it necessary to take precautions during mass time.

- ◆ Reception of the Precious Body **by hand** is recommended at this time.
- ◆ If you are feeling ill or think you may have been exposed to a virus, you should refrain from partaking of the Blood of Christ from the communal chalice.
- ◆ Refrain from offering your hand to others at the sign of peace. A smile and a heartfelt **“Peace be with you”** should suffice.
- ◆ If you are not comfortable sharing the sign of peace or receiving Holy Communion from the communal chalice for fear of infection, you should feel no pressure to do so.

We must all be aware of such sensitive matters in the intimate life of the Christian community and we should expect that some will refrain from the sign of peace and the communal chalice out of care for our well-being and not out of unkindness or a lack of piety.
