

Mass Guidelines:

- ✝ If we have more than 50 people signed up to attend Mass a schedule will be made. You will be contacted and an announcement will be made at the weekend Mass. If you called to RSVP for a Mass you do not need to call the office again, only if you need to make a change. The weekend Mass schedule will be finalized on Friday. The deadline to make changes for the weekend Mass schedule is Friday at 10:00 am, ex. to RSVP, to change to a different Mass or to let us know you will not be attending. You will not be allowed into Mass if your name is not on the list. Only one set of doors will be open: at the St. Pancratius site the main doors and at the St. Agatha site the side doors.
- ✝ Dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect through August 30, 2020.
- ✝ Anyone who is older than 65 years of age (the recommended CDC age), with a compromised health condition or caring for the sick in any way, are at higher risk of contracting COVID-19 and should stay home.
- ✝ Anyone with a cough of any sort, and anyone feeling sick in any way, should not come to Mass.
- ✝ Please maintain the social distancing and sit six feet apart except for couples and families who live in the same household. On the top back of the pews you will find blue tape to mark where to sit.
- ✝ You must wear your mask or face covering during the entire celebration of the Mass.
- ✝ A collection box is located at the entrance of the church to drop your contribution in before or after Mass.
- ✝ Bulletins will not be printed. You can read the bulletin on the parish website and app.
- ✝ Distribution of Communion will be after the Mass. You are to receive Communion in the hand, no gloves are allowed. Fr. Theo will remove his vestment and put on a mask. The ushers will release a pew at a time, please follow the directions from the usher. As you come forward to receive Communion follow the blue crosses on the floor to keep the six feet social distancing. When you are next in line to receive Communion remove your mask/face covering, step forward to receive Communion in your hand, step aside and place the Eucharist in your mouth to consume, place your mask/face covering back over your face and then proceed out the door to the parking lot.
