- What is our Vision for the next three years?
  - o Radical transformation both internal and external 4th Day for the Parish
    - Formation that facilitates radical discipleship and accompaniment. Supported by the staff and community. One person Can't sustain it.
    - Not a new program, but a new way of looking at Discipleship
  - Church going deeper, churched and unchurched
    - Moving each other another step deeper
    - Results in Mass Attendance, Programs explicit to evangelization, both/and approach to unchurched
  - Challenge of engaging Young Adults/Young Families What would it look like to engage this group?
  - Targeting marginally engaged in parish life
    - Personal connections/relationships
    - Create smaller group of parishioners, and reach out to marginal parishioners directly
    - Reaching out within neighborhoods
  - More engagement with particular groups
    - Listening to ideas from groups

- Continued engagement of RE Families
- Bulletin Doing really well
- Within Mass, what is happening, what do we want to experience?
  - Increase in reverence
  - Increase in understanding
  - Education on all levels
- Outside the walls, Some kind of grief/loss/support group for a variety of losses in life
- Strengthening those who are here to be witnesses in the world
  - Confidence to know how to take their faith to comfort someone who is experiencing loss
  - Confidence in talking about faith
- How can we play to our strengths with the different parishes
