

Plenary Indulgence for June 13th

We remind you that The Holy Father has approved a special Plenary indulgence to "the pious faithful who visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church...during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary." Those seeking an indulgence must also pray an Our Father, recite the Creed, invoke Our Lady of Fatima, AND fulfill the "usual conditions" of Confession, receiving the Eucharist, and saying prayers for the intentions of The Holy Father. St. Agnes has a statue of Our Lady of Fatima on the west side of the church, near the sacristy.

Please pray for those who are Called. Pick up a copy of the "Rosary for Vocations" brochure in the narthex. It contains reflections on the Luminous Mysteries that support (1) The universal vocation to be holy, (2) Vocations to marriage, (3) Vocations for permanent deacons, (4) Vocations to Religious life, and (5) Vocations to the Priesthood. The Luminous Mysteries focus especially on the public ministry of Christ, so this Rosary is a simple but fruitful prayer for vocations.

- Names of those to receive the Blessing, type of event, and date.
- A \$20 offering, payable by US check.
