ACE Nights:

Code of Conduct

I understand that as a participant in youth programs at St. Edith Stein, the following behavior is expected:

- I am expected to respect myself. This means I will not willingly put myself in dangerous or harmful situations. I will be on my best behavior at all times.
- I am expected to respect others. This means I will not treat another person in a way I would not want to be treated. I will listen to and obey all rules as directed by adult leaders.
- For my safety I will make sure that an adult chaperone knows where I am at all times.
- For my safety if I am injured or become ill, I will notify an adult chaperone.
- I will promote a Christian environment in my speech and actions.
- I will use appropriate attire for all the activities. This means the appropriate length of shorts and shirts.
- I will not use or be in possession of alcohol, weapons or illegal drugs. I understand that I will be sent home if I violate this rule.
