Purpose:

- ◆ Continue to raise awareness to the evil of racism

Supplies to be used:

- ◆ All volunteers will have t-shirts
- ◆ Front will have the swash cross and the words Prayer...Not Violence
- ◆ Back will have name of the church
- ◆ Purple cross and lettering
- ◆ Professionally made signs 24" x 36" with 1"x1" by 4" wood so it can be held
- ◆ Purple sign...white lettering
- ◆ Sign says End the Sin of Racism with swash cross
- ◆ Bottom of sign will have churches name

Where:

- ◆ Within the rectangle of Richmond, Wilcrest, Briar Forest and Gessner
- ◆ Will start along Westheimer due to high visibility

How:

- ◆ Will go out in groups for 60-90 minutes to be seen
- ◆ Will always start and end at St Cyril
- ◆ Will stay on sidewalks...no streets...no private property
- ◆ Deacon Bob can provide additional details.

When:

- ◆ Target is 6-7 of these through September
- ◆ Target start is a Saturday from 3:00 – 4:30pm
- ◆ Will also do some weeknights... both Tuesdays and Thursdays

Misc:

- ◆ Will hold racism forum...possibly September/October **time-frame** if classroom building is open
- ◆ Will participate in other events in Houston if appropriate
- ◆ Will contact Catholic newspaper and local media once we are active for possible coverage
