Learn the 14 narrative books of the Bible and the 12 major time periods of salvation history. Discover the major people, places, events, & themes of the Bible.

Study the six covenants God made with humanity, leading to the establishment of the Catholic Church.

See how the 14 narrative books fit in with the other 59 books of the Bible.

Learn how to use the color-coded tools to remember the important time-periods of the Old and New Testaments.

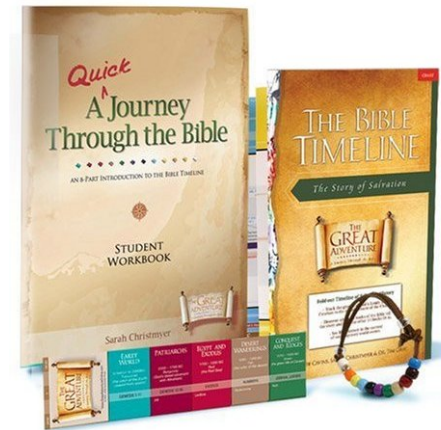

Discover the Catechism of Catholic Church in easy weekly sessions as we discuss chapters from the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults.

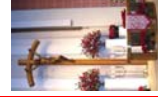
