- I. Growing closer to God through the Sacraments
 - Goal Strengthen our experience of the Sacraments.
 - Objective 1 Introduce a new program for Baptism Preparation
 - Objective 2 Recruit three couples for a new Marriage Preparation program
 - Objective 3 Offer special opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation for those in Faith Formation
 - Objective 4 Hold a Mass with communal Anointing of the Sick twice a year (Spring and Fall) once during the day and once during the evening
 - Objective 5 Have a Blessing of Marriages at significant anniversaries in concert with the Diocesan Mass for Marriages at certain milestones.
- II. Caring for others by sharing the time, talent and treasure entrusted to us
 - Goal Develop and support Sacred Heart Parish stewardship ministries

Objective 1 – Establish a "Mass Transit" ministry to provide transportation to Mass for those in need and recruit a ministry lead and assistant as well as 10 volunteer drivers

Objective 2 – Staff the Welcome Table in the church gathering area with volunteers at 100% of weekend Masses
