

HSA Meeting Minutes 10/7/15

- Meeting started at 6:30pm with a prayer
- Minutes from May 16th meeting were approved
- By-Law changes were approved
 - o Article 9- Field Day and Newcomer Welcome/Host Family
- Membership Drive for HSA participation increased 7% this year. It is at 70% with 278 out of 395 families now participating and helping out HSA. Thank you Morgan Bentley and Claire Morgan for your help with this and thank you to all the families who paid their HSA dues.
- Morgan spoke on the budget
 - o Starting with a roll over balance of \$10,177.79
 - o Bought Last Supper painting hanging between Cafetorium and School- \$342.76
 - o HSA will pay for the following: volunteer t-shirts for field day, incentives for attending meetings, \$500 extra for Teacher Christmas party, pizza for Halloween parties, movie night and auction donation
 - o We anticipate an extra \$5000 in roll over next year for a total roll over of \$15,000
- Safe Environment was highlighted
 - o Many need to still be trained or retrained
