I agree that I have read the St. Mark Catholic School Athletics Handbook, and pages 43-44 in the Parent-Student Handbook, and will abide by the rules and guidelines contained therein.

I will attend and complete all coaching requirements: Safe Environment, CPR and PLC courses.

I will report any infraction of the rules to the school Athletic Director, Marlene Ehring.

I will not contact the DPL Athletic Director at any time for any reason.

I will not contact the school Principal or Vice Principal on sports-related matters without permission from the Athletic Director.

I will comply with all school and league rules and directives.

I will not use alcohol, drugs, or tobacco related products in the presence of players, coaches, officials, or volunteers while representing St. Mark.

I will not use foul or abusive language at any time while representing St. Mark.

I will teach Christian values, respect, discipline, honesty, and hard work.

I will instruct the players in their sportsmanship responsibilities.

I will keep informed and comply by all league rules.

I will take all precautions to protect student athletes, equipment, materials, and facilities.

I will respect the officials' judgment and interpretation of the rules. I will address concerns to officials in a calm manner during dead ball situations.

I will publicly shake hands with the officials and opposing coach before and after the match.

I will instruct my team to shake hands with the opposing team and with the officials after every match.

I will be a proper host to opponents, treating them like guests. I will remind spectators that the opposing team needs their respect and courtesy.

I will discipline those students/athletes who display unsportsmanlike behavior, and if necessary, forfeit the privilege of representing their school.

I will not use corporal punishment for discipline.

I will remain with the athletes until each is released to their parent/guardian, whether at a game or practice.

I will be fair and have an unprejudiced relationship with all team members.

I will make every effort to ensure that players receive a fair amount of playing time. I understand I must be supportive in everything I do and say; I will not assault others verbally or in writing.

I will not use off-site practices unless given permission by the Athletic Director.

I will notify the Athletic Director of concerns addressed to me.

I will not allow any unsupervised children to attend practices. Athletes and coaches must be able to remain focused and disciplined without distractions.

I will always be a good example for others to follow.

I understand conduct that falls outside that listed at practice is subject to disciplinary measures from school.

I understand conduct that falls outside that listed at a match is subject to disciplinary measures from the DPL.
