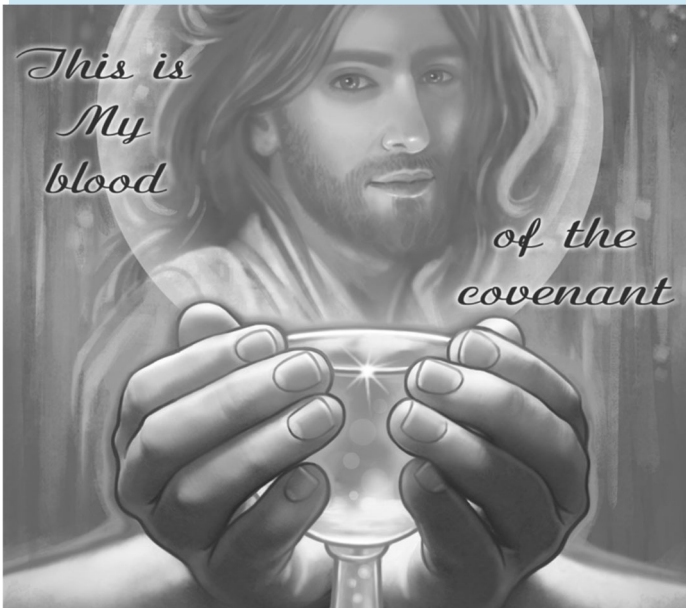

PRECIOUS BLOOD

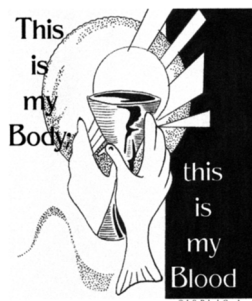
