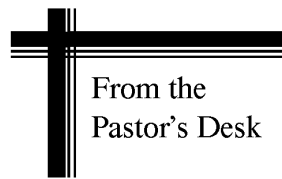

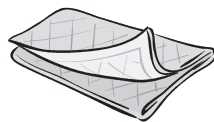

Parish Care Team Annual Report

In 2016, our parish care team provided 1,585 hours of service to parishioners, to residents at our three Lodi residential facilities, and to members of the community at large. The team, composed of 15 parish members, provided 799 hours of transportation (519.75 for medical reasons); 531.75 hours were for "friendly visits" with another 173.75 hours devoted to communion calls and prayer. Additional services include respite care for family care-givers, light chores and phone check-ins. These hours of service, are a beautiful testimony to the depth to which our parish team is committed to be the Hands and Feet of Christ. 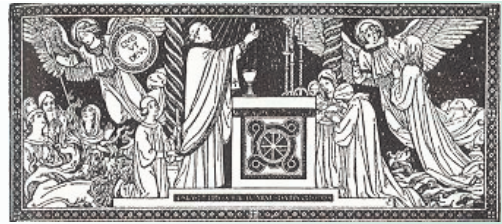
