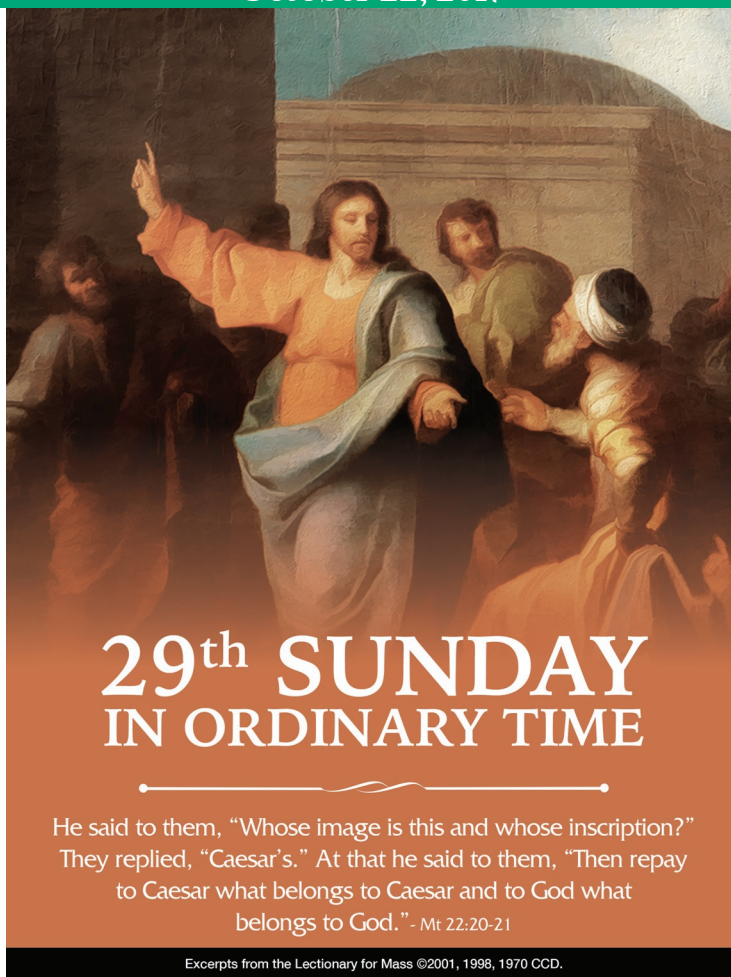

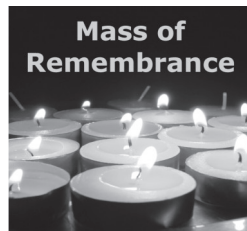
*How can our family be obedient to God like Noah and Abraham?
