*making time for a good confession

*using a Jesse Tree, Advent Calendar, Advent count-down chain, Straw in the Manger, or creating a progressive nativity scene to count the days and encourage our hearts to expand with small acts of kindness and charity toward others.

*reading the promises found in the Old Testament book of the Prophet Isaiah or reading and studying the Christmas Story of the New Testament.

*observing the Holy Day of the Immaculate Conception on December 8 and all the wonderful saints and their feasts of the Season (St. Nicholas Day, St. Lucy Day, Our Lady of Guadalupe).
