A Personal Journey from Islam to Catholicism

Guest speaker, Fariba Roughead will be speaking at Holy Name Heights (702 S. High Point Rd.) on Monday, January 13th at 7:00 pm on her personal journey from Islam to Catholicism. Fariba is a convert from Islam to Catholicism and will share her personal testimony to facilitate interfaith dialogue. Following the model of New Evangelization, as encouraged by the Magisterium and modeled by Saint John Paul II, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI and Pope Francis, Fariba's intention is to deepen mutual understanding and respect, the first essential step to evangelization. Fariba is a wife, mother and grandmother. She has her doctorate in nutrition science and is a Registered Dietitian. Fariba holds a Graduate Certificate of Theology from the Augustine Institute, is a Certified Professional Coactive Coach (CPCCTM) and a Gallup-Certified Strengths Coach, and is a speaker and retreat leader. In 2018, she retired from her role as Vice President of R&D for a global, publicly-traded organization. Fariba is the founder of Ascensia Consulting, LLC. Her coaching and life philosophy is influenced by Aristotle and St. Ignatius who taught that God's Call, our highest life purpose, is where our natural talents meet the deepest hunger in the world.
