Registration Fee

Non-Refundable Registration Fee: \$100 per child \$300 maximum per family

St. Charles Borromeo (Drexel Hill) provides a \$1,000 per student subsidy for registered members of St. Charles Borromeo Parish who actively support the parish. This subsidy applies to students enrolled in SAS – grades 1st through 8th grade only. Any changes in the amount of subsidy will change the tuition charges. Eligibility for these subsidies is determined by the parish providing these subsidies.

St. Philomena (Lansdowne) provides a \$800 per student subsidy for registered members of St. Philomena Parish who actively support the parish. This subsidy applies to students enrolled in SAS – Kindergarten through 8th grade only. Any changes in the amount of subsidy will change the tuition charges. Eligibility for these subsidies is determined by the parish providing these subsidies.

All tuition installment payment plans - monthly – 10 equal installments [June - March]; quarterly [June, September, December & March]; and semi-annual [July & December] are handled through SMART Tuition (www.smarttuition.com). Annual pay families are billed through the parish in early August and are not charged the \$35 SMART Application Fee.
