

Art Rubric for Kindergarten – 2nd grade.

For grading art in Kindergarten, first and second grade I use a simple rubric that has 2 aspects:

1. Work habits. (Student's behavior and how they follow directions during class)
2. Effort put forth by the student. Effort includes craftsmanship and creativity.
(A student being careful, thoughtful and/or creative shows good craftsmanship)

K-2nd	Effort/ Craftsmanship/ Creativity	Work Habits
4	Art project is as complete as the student could make it. Artwork is innovative, well thought out, and thoroughly developed.	Student worked in class entire period. Did not need to be reminded to focus on task and/ or to follow directions.
3	Artwork is complete. Could use some finishing touches. Artwork is thought out.	Student worked in class most of the period. Needed very few reminders to focus on task and/ or to follow directions.
2	Artwork is complete at the most basic level. Could be worked on further, craftsmanship needs more effort.	Student worked in class part of the period. Needed several reminders to focus on task and/ or to follow directions.
1	Artwork appears to still be in-progress.	Student needed many reminders to focus on task.
